GENERAL INFORMATION

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Montessori 101: Devoted to educational enrichment and will be led by Montessori AMI Primary trained guide Savannah Guenther. This part of the program is designed to enhance the knowledge of currently enrolled Primary Montessori children and allow non-enrolled children to experience a Montessori environment for the first time.

The children staying in the afternoons will also be introduced to educational and classic games, gardening, arts & crafts conducive to summer activities. These activities, led by Montessori at Roseborough staff, are designed to enhance cooperative social skills as well as engage the child's interest.

Themed weeks: Weekly themed activities led by Montessori at Roseborough staff are designed to enhance cooperative social skills as well as engage the child's interest. The children will be introduced to educational and classic games, gardening, arts & crafts conducive to summer activities.

DROP OFF AND PICK UP

Arrival for children is at 8:15 a.m. Parking is allowed in the parking lot only. Children should be picked up by the stated pick up time, after which a \$15.00 late fee every 15 minutes will be charged. Only authorized adults may pick up the child. Parents are required to complete the list of adults who are authorized to pick up their child. See back page. All changes to this list need to be submitted in writing to Montessori at Roseborough.

LUNCH

Please send a healthy lunch and water bottle in an insulated lunch box. All containers should be clearly marked with the child's name. It is not possible to heat meals. We ask that you also pack a snack for your child such as a fruit, crackers or cheese. All lunch boxes must be labeled and picked up at the end of each day.

CLOTHING

Many of the art materials in use will not wash out of clothing. We suggest that children wear old clothing or bring a large shirt or smock. The paint shirt will remain in the program room and must be picked up at the end of each week. Tennis shoes, sunscreen and a hat for outdoor activities are essential. Please label all clothing and other items with the child's name. We ask that you send in a change of clothes in a ziplock bag labeled with your child's name.
